

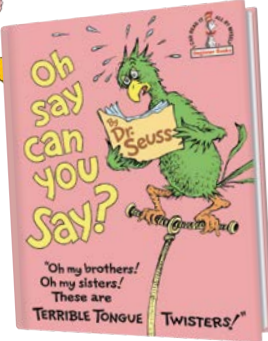
Read. Play. Log your words!
